Community Service- Quick Facts

- Class of 2020: 30 Required Hours for Graduation
- Class of 2021 and beyond: 40 Required Hours for Graduation
- Students must complete 10 hours of Community Service per year.
 - Students who do not complete a minimum of 10 hours of Community Service per year will receive a "U" in the Advisory class at the end of the second semester.
 - Students can complete more than 10 hours in a year and that will reduce the number of hours they need to complete in future years.
- Community Service hours must be earned through a minimum of 2 different activities.
- Students can count a maximum of 20 hours from any one activity towards their required Community Service hours.
