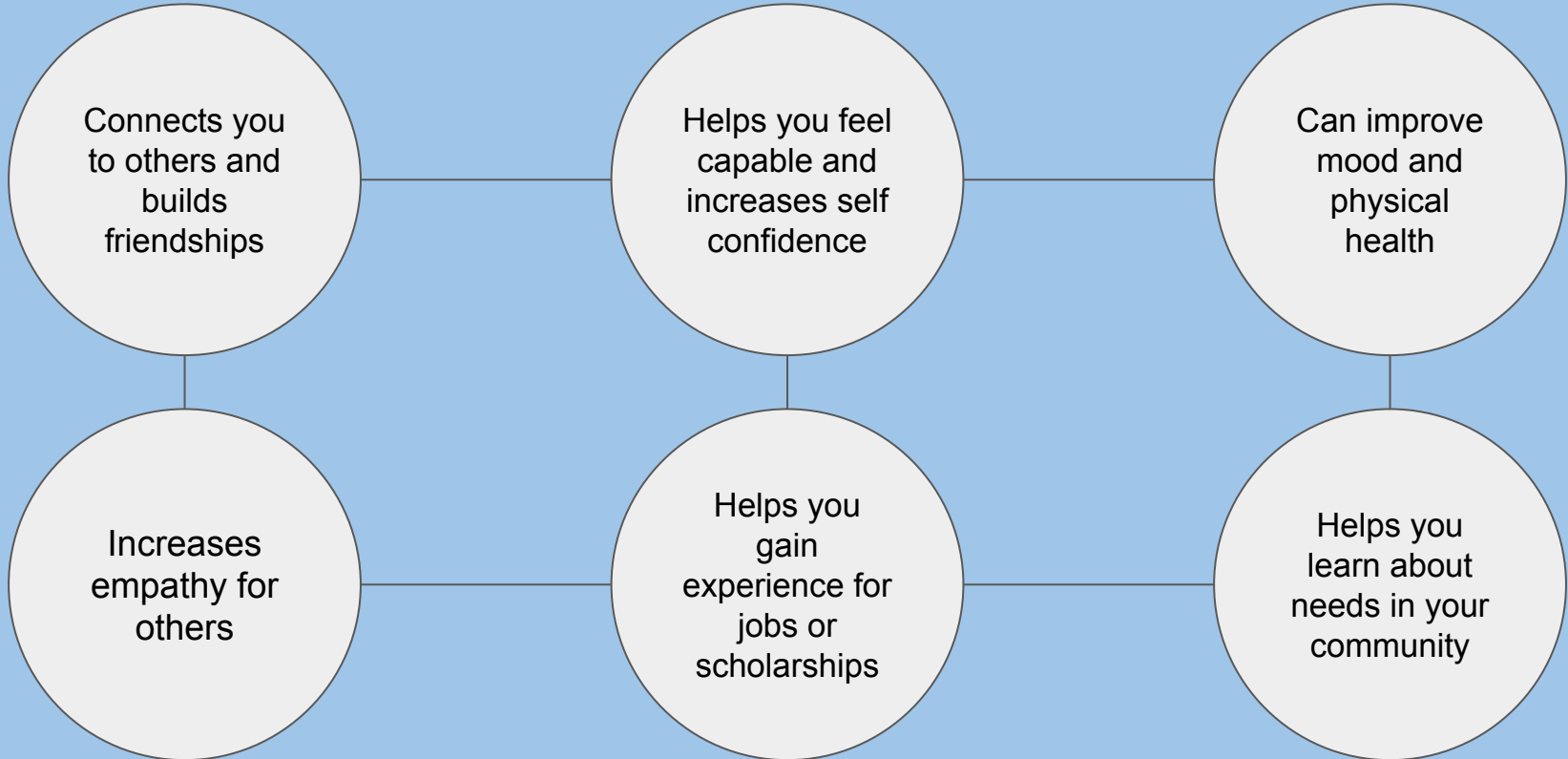

# Key facts about the Community Service Requirement...

## Class of 2020 Students (Current Juniors)

- 30 Required Hours for Graduation
- Students must complete 10 hours of Community Service per year.



## Class of 2021 Students (Current Sophomores)

- 40 Required Hours for Graduation
- Students must complete 10 hours of Community Service per year.



# Key facts continued...

- Students who do not complete a minimum of 10 hours of Community Service per year will receive a “U” (or “Unsatisfactory”) grade in the Advisory class at the end of the second semester.
- Students can complete more than 10 hours in a year and that will reduce the number of hours they need to complete in future years.

# Key Facts continued...

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Community Service hours must be earned through a minimum of 2 different activities.

AND

20

Students can count a maximum of 20 hours from any one activity.

# Documenting your hours....

- Community Service activities must be pre-approved by an MHS Staff Member on the “Community Service Pre-Approval and Reflection” form.
- This is the same form that you will use to document that you completed the activity and how many hours you did.

# Documenting your hours...

- Once you have completely filled out your Reflection Form, turn it into the Counseling Office. See Mrs. Bennett at the front desk.
- Your hours will be logged for you and you can see the information in StudentVue.
- To see your hours in StudentVue:
  - Open StudentVue.
  - Click on the “Gradebook” tab.
  - Click on your “Advisory” class (which is listed as 8th period).
  - Then click on “Assignment View” at the top right hand corner.
  - Look for the assignment titled “Community Service Hours Earned” and you will see the total number of hours we have logged for you.

## REFLECT

Are there issues, causes or places that you care about and want to contribute your time to?

# Key Facts about CRLEs...

**Career Related Learning Experiences** (CRLEs) are events or activities that help students learn about the world of work. These events or activities can help the student learn a skill for applying to jobs, **or** learn about possible career paths, **or** learn about the educational path it takes to get certain jobs.

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Students must complete, and document, 4 CRLEs as a part of the .5 Career Education Credit.

# What type of activities count as CRLEs?

## Activities in Advisory at Mountainside:

- Career Fair
- Practice Job Application
- Practice Resume
- Mock Interview

## Other Activities at Mountainside:

- Career Speaker in the College and Career Center.
- Career Speaker in one of your classes.

## Activities Outside of Mountainside:

- Hillsboro Chamber of Commerce Events (see MHS Students course in Canvas)
- Self Designed through an internship, job shadow or informational interview

# Documenting CRLEs...

- To document a CRLE activity that you completed you need to fill out the CRLE Reflection form.
